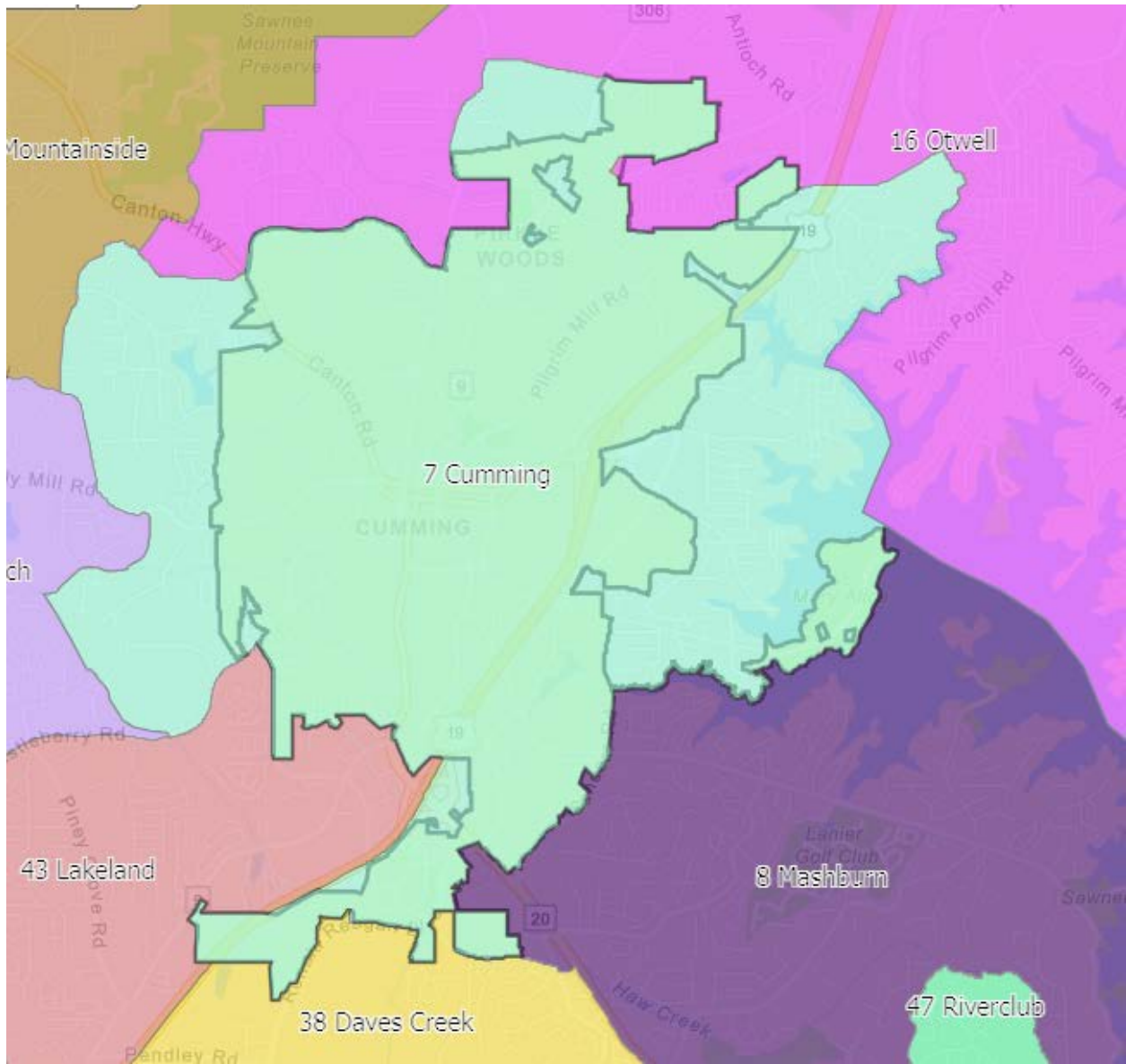
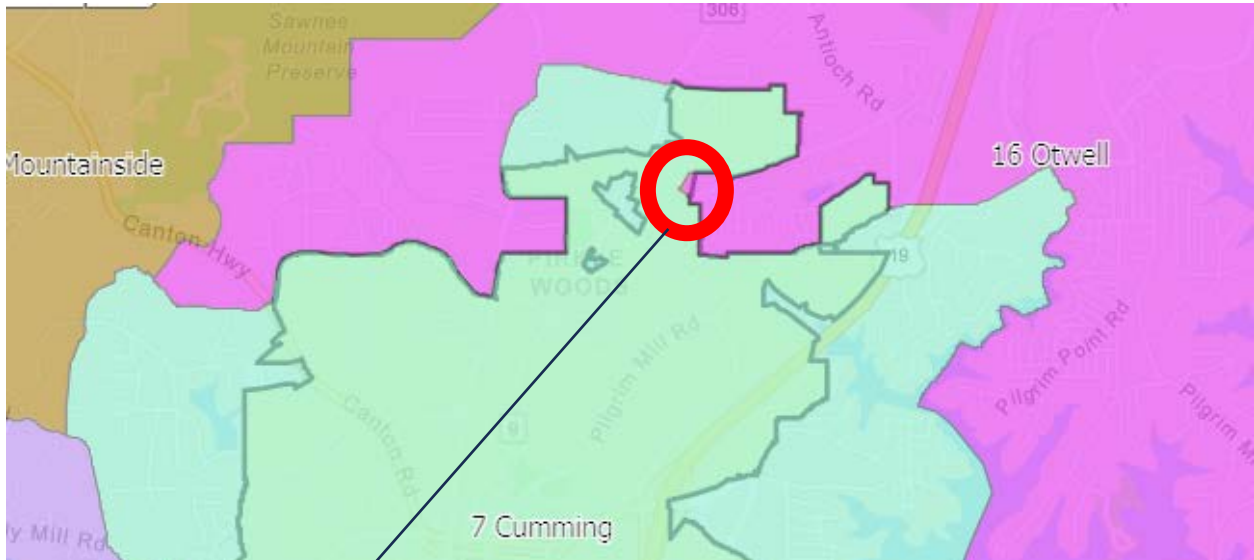


Current Precinct Lines (as of 07/2023)

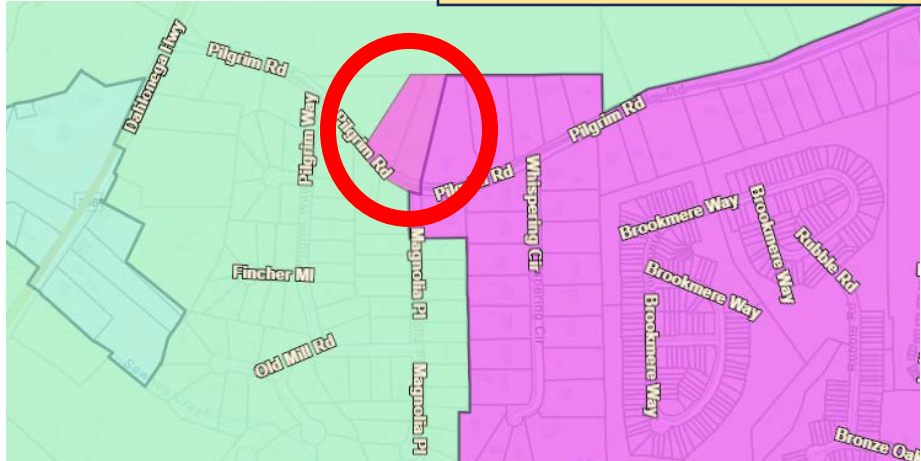


Areas impacted by proposed precinct changes



Two parcels annexed by the City of Cumming.

- C32-047 (approved 08/16/22):
1425 Pilgrim Rd: 4 registered voters
 - Currently in 16-Otwell precinct. Proposed changes will move area to 07-Cumming precinct and within City of Cumming municipal precinct boundary.
- C32-048 (approved 08/16/22):
1435 Pilgrim Rd: 1 registered voter
 - Currently in 16-Otwell precinct. Proposed changes will move area to 07-Cumming precinct and within City of Cumming municipal precinct boundary.



Public Notice of Voting Precinct Changes

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections proposes to change the boundaries of certain voting precincts, as listed below. A hearing to approve a final order adopting these changes is scheduled to take place on September 5, 2023. Any person objecting to any of these changes must file his or her objections prior to September 5, 2023 at the Forsyth County Voter Registrations & Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, GA 30040. Precinct boundary maps with polling places noted are currently on display in the Voter Registrations and Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, GA 30040. Interested citizens are encouraged and invited to view the maps at the office. The available maps illustrate the current precinct configurations as well as the proposed modified precinct configurations and polling places.

Notice of Precinct Boundary Modifications for the City of Cumming municipal voting precinct, the 07-Cumming and 16-Otwell Precincts:

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections does hereby provide notice, as required in O.C.G.A. §21-2-262 (a) and § 21-2-262 (c), of a change of precinct boundaries to account for property annexed by the City of Cumming. The proposed precinct line changes involve the City of Cumming municipal voting precinct, and the 07-Cumming and 16-Otwell precincts. The proposed boundary modification to the City of Cumming municipal voting precinct line will incorporate parcels C01-008, C32-047 and C32-048. Additionally, the proposed boundary modification will re-align the 07-Cumming precinct boundary to be the same as that of the City of Cumming surrounding parcels C32-047 and C32-048, reassigning those affected registered voters in these two parcels from the 16-Otwell precinct to the 07-Cumming precinct. No other changes to the 07-Cumming or 16-Otwell precinct lines are proposed.

The Election Day polling place for the 07-Cumming precinct and the City of Cumming municipal General Election remains Cumming City Hall located at 100 Main Street, Cumming, 30040. The Election Day polling place for the 16-Otwell precinct remains First Baptist Cumming located at 1597 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, 30040.
