Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations & Elections Public Notice of Early Opening and Processing of Absentee Ballots For the March 12, 2024 Presidential Preference Primary

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations & Elections hereby provides public notice of the County Election Superintendent's intent to begin opening absentee ballots prior to the close of the polls on March 12, 2024. Pursuant to Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 21-2-386(a)(2)(A), the Forsyth County Election Superintendent intends to start opening and processing absentee ballots beginning no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 7, 2024. The opening and processing of absentee ballots will continue day to day, including weekend days, if necessary, and take place at the Voter Registrations & Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, GA 30040. Every day, except Election Day, Tuesday, March 12, the process will begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and will end no later than 6:00 p.m., although processing may only occur during a portion of that time depending on staffing levels and the volume of absentee ballots. On Election Day, processing will begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and will continue until complete. The public may view the process as authorized by law.
