Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations & Elections Public Notice of Early Tabulation of Absentee Ballots For the March 12, 2024 Presidential Preference Primary

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations & Elections hereby provides public notice of the County Election Superintendent's intent to begin the absentee ballot tabulation process prior to the close of the polls on March 12, 2024. Pursuant to Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 21-2-386(a)(3), the Forsyth County Election Superintendent shall start the tabulation process for absentee ballots beginning at 2:00 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at the Voter Registrations & Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, GA 30040 in order to expedite the final tabulation of absentee ballots. Monitors may view the tabulation process as authorized by O.C.G.A. § 21-2-386(a)(3). In addition, all persons conducting the tabulation of absentee ballots on March 12, 2024, including the Vote Review Panel, shall be sequestered until the time for the closing of the polls.
