2017 Budget Update: Millage Rates Remain Unchanged



At their July 21 meeting, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners adopted the millage rates that will fund a major portion of the county's 2017 General Fund budget, Fire District and Bonds. The board voted to maintain the county's millage rates with no change. The county's millage rate of 8.036 is one of the lowest millage rates among metro Atlanta counties.

Forsyth County staff, Finance Committee and Board of Commissioners will continue preparing the county's proposed 2017 budget, which is slated for adoption in November.

Tennis Courts Resurfacing at Central Park and Fowler Park

The Central Park tennis courts were resurfaced this summer and are now open for play. The park features eight lighted tennis courts adjacent to a pavilion and restrooms. Fowler Park tennis courts will be resurfaced this month. Fowler Park features 12 stadium lighted tennis courts with a pavilion and restrooms. All Parks & Recreation tennis courts are first come, first served unless otherwise reserved for lessons, drills or league play. Comprehensive Plan Update: Draft Plan Open Houses — See what you've made!

Forsyth County's Comprehensive Plan update process, *Foster Forsyth*, continues to move forward this month. The planning team spent July continuing to synthesize community input collected during preceding months, while turning its attention to drafting the updated plan document. A joint Vision and Steering Committee meeting held on July 14 served as an important check-in point with committee members to review draft plan content, seek feedback and help ensure the plan's development to date was compatible with community sentiment.

This month, *Foster Forsyth* will hold two open houses, giving community members an opportunity to review highlights from the draft plan, discuss aspects with planning team members and offer feedback to refine it. Last month, a key step in the budget process occurred with the board's adoption of the county's millage rates. These rates will fund in part Forsyth County's 2017 general operating budget. I am pleased to advise that we were able to maintain the same millage rates as last year – a total of 8.036 for Maintenance & Operations, Fire and Bonds. Your

county staff and officials work hard to keep the tax levy on citizens as low as possible while also providing the very best services our county desires.

We will continue working on the proposed 2017 budget, on which public hearings will be held later this year. As always, your attendance and input at these hearings will be welcomed and encouraged.
