# **New Fire Station 6 Now Open in South Forsyth County**

Fire Station 6, located just off of SR 141 on Caney Road, celebrated its grand opening on Monday, March 27, with a traditional hose uncoupling ceremony. The new station is a four-stall station, designed to accommodate the personnel and equipment that will operate out of the facility currently and to allow for future growth.

The Forsyth County Fire Department has 13 fire stations, and naming the new facility Station 6 fills a gap in the facilities' numbering.



# Lanierland Park Now Open in Northeast Forsyth County

Lanierland Park, located at 6115 Jot-Em-Down Road, is now open to the public. Phase I of the park includes four rectangular synthetic turf fields, four picnic pavilions, a playground, restroom and concession facilities, and parking.

The county purchased the land for Lanierland Park in 2009 with funds from the Parks, Recreation and Green Space Bond. Prior to the county's purchase of the property, it was the site of Lanierland Music Park, which closed in 2006.
