OLD ATLANTA ROAD

PHASE IV + V FACT SHEET

Description of the Project

The project will widen the existing two-lane road to four lanes, two lanes in each direction, with a 20-foot wide raised median, shoulders, curb and gutter.

The project will also include a five-foot sidewalk and a 10-foot multiuse trail from St. Marlo to James Burgess Road. The length of the project is 2.1 miles.

Construction Steps*

The project will have staged construction

- **Right of Way Acquisition: Spring 2020**
- **Final plans: February 2020**
- **Construction Contract Bid - Award: Summer 2020**
- **Construction Complete: Fall 2022***

Traffic Control

Stage construction and traffic control devices will be utilized to maintain traffic during construction. Temporary lane closures may be required during construction.



* Construction completion dates are estimated and dependant upon weather and other unforeseen factors. Construction completion dates should not be taken as an indicator that the road will be open to traffic on a specific date.

History & Funding

The Old Atlanta Road widening project was originally identified in the 2002 Major Transportation Plan. Parallel to State Route 141, Old Atlanta Road is a thru traffic diverter for vehicles. Constructed in phases since the original concept, Phases IV and V were approved in SPLOST VII by voters and additionally funded by the 2014 bond obligation for various transportation projects.
