Notice to Voters **Change in Election Day Polling Places** **For the July 15, 2025 Special Primary Runoff**

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 21-2-270, only one polling place will be open for the runoff election to be held in Forsyth County on July 15, 2025. This election is a Special Primary Runoff for the nomination of a Democratic Party candidate for the Public Service Commission Special Election. The Election Day polling place for this Runoff election for all Forsyth County registered voters will be located at the **Cumming Recreation & Parks Department Event Center, 437 Pilgrim Mill Road, Cumming, GA 30040**. Any voters who desire to vote in the Special Primary Runoff must vote at said Election Day polling place as no other Election Day polling places will be open for this election. On Election Day, July 15, the polling place will be open for voting between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Voters also have options for casting a ballot prior to Election Day. Any Forsyth County registered voter may take advantage of voting early during Advance Voting the week prior to Election Day. Advance voting will take place at the Forsyth County Voter Registrations & Elections Office from Monday, July 7 through Friday, July 11, between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily. There will be no Saturday or Sunday voting for this runoff. If you wish to vote by absentee ballot, please submit an application to our office no later than Monday, July 7, 2025.

As the Special Primary Runoff is for the nomination of a candidate for the Democratic Party, only voters who cast a Democratic ballot in the June 17, 2025 Special Primary, or who did not vote in the Special Primary, will be eligible to vote in the Special Election Runoff.
