NATIONAL SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT TO TAKE FIELD
AT FORSYTH COUNTY'S CENTRAL PARK

Parks and Recreation chosen from eight departments to host championship

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – The Forsyth County Parks and Recreation Department will host the 2009 Amateur Softball Association (ASA) National Coed Class C Slow Pitch Softball Championship August 28 and 29, at Central Park. The tournament includes 14 teams from 10 states, including Georgia, Alabama and Wisconsin.

To host the 2009 tournament, the Parks and Recreation Department placed a bid at the 2007 ASA National Conference. The more than 300 voting members of ASA selected Forsyth County from eight departments around the United States that placed a bid.

All citizens are invited to attend the softball tournament. Tournament passes will be \$8 for adults and \$5 for students (ages 12-17). A tournament pass includes admission to both days. Friday tickets will be \$3 for adults and \$2 for students. Saturday tickets will be \$6 for adults and \$4 for students. Children under 12 will be admitted free with a paying adult.
