**MAKE YOUR OWN RAIN BARREL**  
**DURING SIX SUMMER AND FALL WORKSHOPS**

*KFCB encourages year-round water conservation*

**FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia** – Encouraging year-round water conservation, Keep Forsyth County Beautiful (KFCB) will host six interactive workshops during the summer and fall for participants to make their own rain barrels. Rain barrels serve as a popular method to capture and conserve rain water.

Two workshops will be held July 7 and August 6 from 6:30 to 8 p.m. at Central Park. Additional workshops will be held August 24, September 17 and October 21 from 6:30 to 8 p.m. and October 3 from 1 to 2:30 p.m. at the Sawnee Mountain Preserve Visitor Center.

The workshop enrollment fee is \$45, which includes a plastic food-grade barrel and all needed supplies to construct a rain barrel. The enrollment fee must be received prior to the workshop. Only cash or check is accepted. Class size is limited for each workshop.

Central Park is located at 2300 Keith Bridge Road (Hwy. 306) in Cumming. The Sawnee Mountain Preserve Visitor Center is located at 4075 Spot Road in Cumming.
