**RESIDENTS INVITED TO LEARN TIPS FOR ENJOYING  
THE BIG CREEK GREENWAY SAFELY**

**FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia** – Forsyth County citizens are invited to learn more about staying safe while enjoying the new Big Creek Greenway multi-use trail. A ‘Safety on the Big Creek Greenway’ event will be held Tuesday, October 20, from 10 a.m. to noon at the Midway Park Community Building. At the event, representatives from the Forsyth County Sheriff’s Office and Forsyth County park rangers will provide information about trail rules and regulations, hours of operation, trail patrols and safety precautions.

The Midway Park Community Building is located at 5100 Post Road in Cumming.

**ABOUT THE BIG CREEK GREENWAY**

The Big Creek Greenway in Forsyth County is a 12-foot wide concrete and boardwalk path meandering through the deciduous woods along the Big Creek. The greenway offers an ideal setting for walking, jogging, biking and inline skating.

Phases 2 and 3 of the trail are now open for use. These phases start at SR 9 and end at Bethelview Road, covering approximately 2.94 miles. Work is continuing on Phase 1, which starts at McFarland Parkway and ends at the Fowler Park site at SR 9.
