FORSYTH COUNTY FIRE STATION #15 TO CLOSE
TEMPORARILY FOR FACILITY REPAIRS

Personnel, equipment to operate from Fire Station #1

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Forsyth County Fire Station #15 will temporarily close beginning Monday, November 2, to allow for repair work to the station’s driveway and parking areas. Fire Station #15 is located at 1525 Buford Highway.

During the closure, personnel and apparatus from Fire Station #15 will operate out of Fire Station #1, located at 234 Castleberry Industrial Drive.

“The condition of the driveway and parking area at Fire Station #15 could create a potential safety hazard to our personnel as they respond to emergencies, and could also be a potential danger to the fire apparatus,” Fire Chief Danny Bowman said.

The work is expected to take approximately one month, weather permitting.

Similar repair work was recently completed at Fire Station #14 on McFarland Parkway. That station’s personnel and equipment are currently operating out of Fire Station #2 while the new concrete cures to the proper strength for fire apparatus.

“It is important to note the territories of Fire Station #14 and Fire Station #15 are not directly adjacent to one another, and thus the simultaneous closures will not adversely impact responses to their districts,” Bowman said. “With every action the Fire Department takes, the safety of our citizens is always foremost in our thoughts.”

Residents are reminded to always dial 911 in the event of an emergency.
