OPEN HOUSE REGARDING PROPOSED
SHARON ROAD WIDENING AND RECONSTRUCTION
TO BE HELD SEPTEMBER 28

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – The Forsyth County Engineering Department will hold a public information open house Monday, September 28, to provide citizens with information regarding a proposed project that would improve Sharon Road from SR 141/Peachtree Parkway to Old Atlanta Road. The open house will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. at South Forsyth Middle School, located at 2865 Old Atlanta Road.

This project proposes widening the existing two-lane Sharon Road to a four-lane roadway with turn lanes as needed. The existing roadway consists of two 12-foot lanes with 8-foot grass shoulders. This project proposes to widen Sharon Road to four 12-foot lanes with a 20-foot raised grass or concrete median, curb and gutter, and 5-foot sidewalks on both sides of the roadway. The widening of the existing roadway will vary in locations along the project corridor to minimize property impacts. Intersection improvements, including turn lanes and intersection realignments, will also be included for a number of side roads along the project corridor.

The open house will be informal and the public is invited to attend anytime between the hours of 5 and 7 p.m.
