FORSYTH COUNTY CEREMONY WILL REMEMBER
SEPTEMBER 11, 2001

Event will be held at Forsyth County's Public Safety Complex

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Forsyth County will take a moment to remember and honor those lost September 11, 2001 during a brief ceremony to be held Friday, September 11 at the county's Public Safety Complex. The ceremony begins at 11 a.m.

“We will never forget those lost through the tragic events of September 11, 2001,” Fire Chief Danny Bowman said. “As public safety professionals and as Americans, we will pause on this September 11 to remember those victims and pay tribute to the heroes who serve our community every day.”

The Forsyth County Public Safety Complex houses a memorial comprised of a portion of a steel I-beam from the New York City World Trade Center. At the time Forsyth County's portion of the I-beam was received from the New York Fire Department, it was one of only two FDNY had entrusted to other departments. Additionally, Forsyth County's piece was the beam from which the FDNY memorial medallions, which were given to the families of the fallen New York firefighters, were cut. The memorial is located in the foyer of the Public Safety Complex and will be a part of the ceremony September 11.

The Forsyth County Public Safety Complex is located at 3520 Settingdown Road in Cumming.
