Dawson Forest Canoe Trip (all skill levels/10-person maximum)

Activity 267320-A: Saturday, March 27, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., ages 12 and up (under 16 must be accompanied by adult), \$40 for county residents and \$50 for non-county residents, meet at SMP Visitor Center

The SMP Tribble Gap parking area is located at 2500 Bettis-Tribble Gap Road and the SMP Visitor Center is located at 4075 Spot Road. Pre-registration is required for all programs.
