**SHILOH ROAD TO REOPEN FOR MOTORISTS**

**FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia** – Construction of a concrete box culvert on Shiloh Road is complete and the section of roadway that has been closed is scheduled to reopen for motorists at approximately 6 p.m. this evening.

“The road will reopen to traffic this evening,” Assistant Director of Engineering Tim Allen said. “The reclamation work will still need to be completed with the asphalt overlay at a later date when temperatures warm up. The utility providers will be working to get their lines reburied over the next few weeks in preparation for the guard rail installation.”

A portion of Shiloh Road had been closed to through traffic approximately 1,500 feet northeast of McFarland Parkway since November, to allow for the culvert construction. The project is funded by the current Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax program, SPLOST VI.

“This culvert was replaced in the interest of public safety, to help ensure a safe roadway for drivers,” Director of Engineering John Cunard said. “We are very appreciative of motorists’ patience throughout this project.”

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
