BOIL WATER ADVISORY ISSUED FOR
NORTH FORSYTH COUNTY

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Until further notice, Forsyth County advises county water customers in north Forsyth County to boil water that will be used for consumption. The area under the advisory is the north portion of the county, generally north of State Route 369 (Matt Highway), east of Elmo and Westray Roads, including Holtzclaw Road.

All residents and businesses who experienced low water pressure or an outage are advised to boil all water before use for drinking, cooking or preparing baby food, until the advisory has been lifted. The water should be boiled for at least one minute after reaching a rolling boil.

Forsyth County had to shut down a large diameter supply line earlier today for repair. During this time, some customers experienced low water pressure. While no contaminants are believed to have entered the water system, the boil water advisory is being issued out of safety and precaution. The advisory will remain in place until tests can be completed, which will take a minimum of 24 hours.
