*Report details water quality in 2009*

**FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia** – The Forsyth County Water and Sewer Department’s 2010 Water Quality Report is now available and will be mailed to customers with water bills throughout June. The report, which covers 2009, provides information on where the county’s water comes from, what it contains and how it compares to standards set by the regulatory agencies. In 2009, Forsyth County’s water met all U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and state drinking water health standards.
