**BIG CREEK GREENWAY RECEIVES AWARD FOR
ENGINEERING EXCELLENCE**

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – The Georgia Engineering Alliance recently recognized Forsyth County’s Big Creek Greenway for engineering excellence. The trail received an Honor Award for Engineering Excellence February 20, during an event that was part of Georgia Engineers Week.

The awards are designed to celebrate engineering accomplishments and acknowledge the importance of the engineering profession in the community, nation and world. Engineering Excellence Awards were presented for projects based on their contributions to society, originality and complexity, among other criteria.

Representatives from Pond & Company, the firm who designed the Big Creek Greenway in Forsyth County, and Tim Allen, Forsyth County’s assistant director of engineering, accepted the award.

The Big Creek Greenway is a 12-foot wide concrete and boardwalk path meandering through the deciduous woods along the Big Creek. The trail offers an ideal setting for walking, jogging, biking and inline skating. Phases 1, 2 and 3 opened in 2009 and offer nearly seven miles of trail. Future Phases 4 and 5 are still in the design phase.
