FORSYTH COUNTY APPROVES
EMERGENCY SUPPLIER NETWORK

Vendors may offer commodities, services during times of emergency

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Forsyth County government is taking extra steps to ensure a prompt response in providing supplies and services to local residents during times of emergency.

During the October 7 regular meeting, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners approved the establishment of an Emergency Supplier Network. This network would consist of vendors offering a service or commodity needed by a government agency during a time of a declared emergency. The county’s Purchasing Department would utilize the network list to obtain needed goods and services during an emergency situation.

“The goal is to be prepared, and to have this Emergency Supplier Network established and ready to go,” said Forsyth County Procurement Director Donna Kukarola. “We welcome any business that believes it would be able to help Forsyth County in times of emergency to participate.”

The Emergency Supplier Network would help streamline Forsyth County emergency recovery efforts and provide local residents with assurances they may rely on the company in the Network. When a state of emergency is declared, the company will be expected to mobilize to meet Forsyth County’s needs while maintaining reasonable prices for goods and services.
