**PUBLIC INPUT SOUGHT FOR UPDATE TO
COUNTY'S RECREATION MASTER PLAN**

Two public information meetings to be held

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Forsyth County's Recreation Master Plan is being updated to provide guidance for the development of future park and recreation facilities. The Forsyth County Parks and Recreation Department will host two public information meetings to receive input to be used in preparing the update to the Recreation Master Plan. The meetings will be held August 23 and 24 and will provide residents an opportunity to contribute their suggestions relative to improving the county's recreation system.

The purpose of the Recreation Master Plan is to determine the type, number and location of future parks, facilities, programs, open space and trails to be provided to meet present and future needs of county residents.

“We encourage residents to attend these public information meetings and provide their input,” Director of Parks and Recreation Jerry Kinsey said. “The Recreation Master Plan helps us prepare and plan for the future, so citizen input is a very important part of this process.”
