**NEW DOG PARK OPENS AT
FORSYTH COUNTY'S FOWLER PARK**

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – A new dog park opened Friday, July 8 at Forsyth County's Fowler Park. The fenced area allows dogs to play and run in a confined grassy area without leashes. One section of the 1.5 acre space is for small dogs and the other is for large dogs (those weighing 35 pounds or more).

"We are very excited to open this amenity to our residents and their dogs, and expect it will be a very popular part of Fowler Park," Parks and Recreation Director Jerry Kinsey said. "We are certainly appreciative of the voter-approved Bond funding that made Fowler Park and this new dog park possible."

Fowler Park is located at 4110 Carolene Way. The park opened in February and was funded by the \$100 million Parks, Recreation and Green Space Bond approved by voters in 2008. In addition to the new dog park, Fowler Park features athletic fields, a skate park, playground, trail head for the Big Creek Greenway, walking trails, and tennis and basketball courts.

The new dog park is the county's second. The first is located at Windermere Park at 3355 Windermere Parkway.
