NEW HOURS IN EFFECT BEGINNING APRIL 1
AT CENTRAL PARK RECREATION CENTER

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Beginning Friday, April 1, new hours of operation will be in effect for Forsyth County’s Central Park Recreation Center. The revised Recreation Center hours are being implemented as a cost-saving measure. Under the revised schedule, the center’s hours of operation Monday through Thursday will remain the same; hours for Friday and Saturday have been adjusted; and the center will now be closed on Sundays.

“We thoroughly reviewed the center’s usage to determine how reduced hours could be implemented with as minimal an impact on our patrons as possible,” said Recreation Division Manager Jim Brennan. “The adjusted hours still allow us to keep the center open for nearly 70 hours Monday through Saturday.”

Hours of operation for the Central Park Recreation Center, effective April 1, 2011:

Monday – Thursday: 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.
Friday: 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
Saturday: 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.
Sunday: Closed

The revised hours were approved by the Board of Commissioners December 2, 2010 following recommendation from staff and the Parks and Recreation Board.

“We will continue to monitor and evaluate the center’s usage,” said Director of Parks and Recreation Jerry Kinsey. “We appreciate citizens’ understanding during this transition.”

Central Park Recreation Center is located at 2300 Keith Bridge Road (Hwy. 306). The facility includes two gymnasiums; fitness area; mezzanine walking area; classrooms for art, dance and fitness; meeting rooms; and a banquet room.
