**NEW PRELIMINARY FORSYTH COUNTY FLOOD HAZARD
MAPS TO BE DISPLAYED DURING OPEN HOUSE**

Citizens invited to learn how maps affect flood insurance requirements

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Forsyth County’s flood risk information has recently been revised and citizens are invited to review the new preliminary maps during an upcoming open house.

On Monday, October 24, an open house will be held from 5:30 to 7 p.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room (Suite 220) in the Forsyth County Administration Building, located at 110 E. Main Street in Cumming. The open house will provide citizens an opportunity to learn how the updated maps can possibly affect building and flood insurance requirements.

During the open house, representatives from local government, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will be available to provide information and answer questions.

The maps are also currently available for viewing in the Forsyth County Department of Engineering, Suite 120 in the Forsyth County Administration Building, located at 110 E. Main Street in Cumming.
