TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NICHOLS DRIVE

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Nichols Drive will be temporarily closed to through traffic between James Burgess Road and Nichols Road beginning Monday, May 27. The closure will allow for the replacement of a failing pipe and the construction of a new reinforced box culvert that will be sized to better handle heavy rains, which will improve safety in the area. The road is expected to re-open on or before Friday, August 2, weather permitting.

“We appreciate motorists’ patience during this temporary closure,” Director of Engineering John Cunard said.

The Nichols Drive project is funded by SPLOST VI. SPLOST, or Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax, is a voter-approved, one-percent sales tax that has been in effect in Forsyth County since 1983. Forsyth County’s current SPLOST program, SPLOST VI, was approved by voters February 5, 2008, and went into effect July 1, 2008.
