FORSYTH COUNTY GOVERNMENT CABLE CHANNEL
NOW AVAILABLE ON AT&T U-VERSE

Channel features live meetings, original programming and more

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – More people will now be able to tune in and keep up with Forsyth County government via television, as TV Forsyth expands to AT&T U-Verse.

TV Forsyth is Forsyth County’s 24-hour government cable channel and has been broadcast on Comcast channel 23 since late 2007. It is now also available on AT&T U-Verse channel 99. AT&T U-Verse customers must first tune in to channel 99 and then follow the menu navigation options to select TV Forsyth.

“We are excited that more citizens now have access to the county government’s television programming, providing them with another avenue for keeping informed about the county,” said Director of Communications Jodi Gardner.

About TV Forsyth

TV Forsyth airs live the meetings of the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners, Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals. Those meetings are also rebroadcast on the channel, as are Board of Commissioners’ work sessions and meetings of the Forsyth County Board of Education. In addition to coverage of county meetings, TV Forsyth airs original programming designed to keep residents informed about the programs and services provided by their county government. The channel also features electronic bulletin board messages providing timely information about government meetings, events, programs and more.
