Report details water quality in 2013

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – The Forsyth County Water and Sewer Department will be mailing the 2014 Water Quality Report to county water and sewer customers with their bills, beginning May 22. Customers will receive the report with their monthly bill.

The report provides information from 2013 on where the county’s water comes from, what it contains and how it compares to standards set by the regulatory agencies. Forsyth County’s water met all U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and state drinking water health standards in 2013.
