**UPDATE REGARDING PARKING NEAR
FORSYTH COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING**

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Work related to the construction of the Mason Street Parking Facility near the Forsyth County Administration Building in downtown Cumming will result in the temporary loss of access to a parking area near the building.

Work in the area will require the temporary closure of a portion of Mason Street. The entrance to Mason Street off of Main Street is scheduled to close on Saturday, November 8. This will result in the loss of access to the parking lot off of Mason Street that currently has spaces for both public parking and Forsyth County employee parking.

The five-level, 491-space Mason Street Parking Facility is slated to open later this year. It is the second of two parking decks that are part of the new courthouse and jail project funded by the voter-approved Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) VII program. The three-level, 222-space Castleberry Parking Facility at the intersection of Castleberry Road and Maple Street opened this summer.

In addition to the Castleberry Parking Facility, weekday daytime public parking spaces are available at several locations near the County Administration Building (please see map at www.forsythco.com). Look for the parking spaces marked with a red dot in designated lots.
