**FORSYTH COUNTY TO OFFER EXTENDED HOURS**  
**DURING WEEK THREE OF ADVANCE VOTING**

*Polls open during week three of Advance Voting from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.*

**FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia** – Forsyth County voters will have additional time to cast their ballot during week three of Advance Voting for the November 4 General Election/Special Election, thanks to extended Advance Voting hours approved by the Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections.

On Saturday, October 25, and from Monday, October 27 through Friday, October 31, five Advance Voting locations throughout Forsyth County will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Registered Forsyth County voters can vote during Advance Voting at any of these five locations, regardless of their Election Day designated precinct.

“The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections voted to extend the voting hours during week three of Advance Voting,” said Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections Chairman Donald Glover. “This decision was made by us [the Board] in a concerted effort to better accommodate and serve all voters in Forsyth County. We hope the voters of Forsyth County take advantage of these additional voting hours.”

For those casting a ballot during Advance Voting at the Forsyth County Administration Building in downtown Cumming, public parking areas include the Castleberry Parking Facility at the intersection of Castleberry Road and Maple Street, limited spaces at the County Administration Building and designated voter parking spaces behind Cumming City Hall. Parking at and near the County Administration Building is limited due to construction.

For all in-person voting, voters should remember to bring one of the six acceptable forms of photo identification. Remember, there is NO voting on Monday, November 3. If you are unable to take advantage of Advance Voting you will need to go to your designated polling location on Tuesday, November 4. Polls will be open on November 4 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. NOTE: Due to changes in precinct boundary lines and polling locations in December 2013 it is highly possible your voting precinct and/or polling location may have changed. Please verify your Election Day precinct at [www.mvp.sos.ga.gov](http://www.mvp.sos.ga.gov) prior to heading out to vote.
