PUBLIC INPUT MEETING REGARDING MASTER PLAN
FOR PROPOSED WILDCAT CREEK PARK

FORSYTHCOUNTY, Georgia – Forsyth County Parks and Recreation is holding a public input meeting on Monday, September 14 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss the master plan for the proposed Wildcat Creek Park in northeastern Forsyth County. The meeting will be held at the Coal Mountain Park Community Building located at 3560 Settingdown Road.

The Forsyth County Board of Commissioners has been given the opportunity by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to lease and develop several lake parks in the county. The board voted in February to move forward with the master planning of the approximately 20-acre peninsula at the end of Crystal Cove Trail called Wildcat Creek Park.

The community is invited to attend this public input meeting and share their ideas for the potential future development of this park.

District 4 Commissioner and Vice Chairman Cindy Jones Mills, whose district includes Wildcat Creek Park, encouraged citizens to attend the meeting.

“We invite residents to join us for this meeting and share their ideas for what they might like to see included in the master plan for this proposed park,” said Jones Mills. “This input will help us formulate a conceptual master plan for this property.”
