Open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
  - **Sexton Hall Enrichment Center**, 2115 Chloe Road  
Open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
  - **Hearthstone Lodge Community Center**, 7305 Lanier Drive  
Open Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
2. Acquire a gift. Each gift request tag lists the name of a local senior citizen along with a gift idea for him/her.
3. Bring the unwrapped gift – in a gift bag with the gift request tag attached – to any of the three Forsyth County Senior Services locations listed above weekdays by November 27.
