The cleanup is part of the Lake Lanier Association's 2018 Lake Lanier Shore Sweep event and will take place Saturday, September 15, from 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. Families, co-workers, organizations, scout troops and individuals are encouraged to volunteer for the annual waterway cleanup event on Lake Lanier and its tributaries.
