### **FORSYTH COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RECEIVE RECOGNITION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE ACCG LIFELONG LEARNING ACADEMY**

*Three commissioners recognized for the achievement*

**Forsyth County, Georgia** – At the Nov. 15 Board of Commissioners regular meeting, Forsyth County Commissioners Dennis Brown, Cindy Jones Mills and Laura Semanson were recognized for the completion of their continuing education requirements within the Association County Commissioners of Georgia (ACCG) Lifelong Learning Academy.

According to the commissioners recognized, the information attained in the Lifelong Learning Academy has played a key role in the decisions they make as county officials and provides them knowledge of the various ways to effectively address issues impacting Forsyth County.

Classes offered in the Lifelong Learning Academy are designed to advance the functionality of county government by imparting new information to county officials. In collaboration with the Carl Vinson Institute of Government, ACCG has sculpted the courses to provide officials with tools and resources to effectively navigate their role as a county official.
