Recycling Convenience Centers Can Help with Spring Cleaning

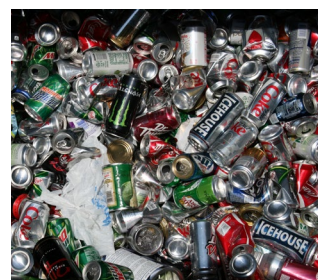
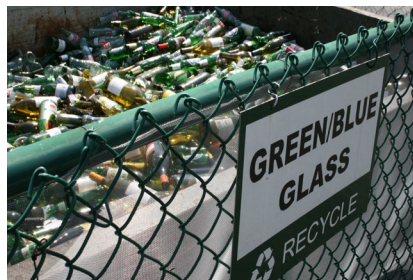
