Southeast Forsyth Boundary residential subdivisions

- (1) <u>Monument Signs</u>. Monument Signs located at the entrance of residential subdivisions shall comply with the following standards:
 - (a) <u>Sign Supports.</u> The supporting sign structure may be constructed with the following durable materials:
 - (i) Brick: Full-depth masonry brick, but not adhered brick veneers;
 - (ii) Stone: Unpainted natural stone, unpainted cast stone having the appearance of natural stone, and unpainted terra cotta;
 - (b) <u>Sign Supports Disallowed.</u> The supporting structure may not be constructed of wood, treated or untreated
 - (c) <u>Sign Face</u>. Sign faces may be composed of the following materials:
 - (i) Metal: painted or unpainted;
 - (ii) Wood: treated to withstand water or painted;
 - (iii) Synthetic material having the appearance of wood or metal;
 - (iv) Any material permitted for the supporting structure
 - (d) Lighting. Internally illuminated signs are prohibited
