RESIDENTIAL MANUFACTURED MOBILE HOME PERMIT PACKET

CHECKLIST

Manufactured Mobile Homes must be obtained in office

Please complete the entire application package, including:

- Permit Details Form**
- Plat** – Copy of approved recorded plat
- Site Plan (1 Copy – 8 ½ x 11 required)**
 - Actual dimensions of property
 - Size and location of building on property showing distance from property lines
 - Driveway location
 - Location of any existing structures on property
 - Porch and deck located on mobile home
- Proof of Water**
 - Water meter purchase
 - Well Affidavit (if water is provided by well the Affidavit will be provided by Planning office clerk)

- Affidavits**
 - Mobile Home Contractor** – Must provide a copy of Mobile Home Installation State License and Business license

Contractor Affidavits – Required. (Must be signed, notarized and submitted with building permit application with copies of current business license, state contractor license). Please do not include copies of driver's license.

- Electrical Sub-Contractor Affidavit

OR

Self Work Affidavit (if applicable) can be found on the Forsythco.com website. This form is used when the homeowner is taking responsibility of the electrical work that is being done. It must be Notarized.

- Mobile Home Placement Letter** to verify zoning and acreage of property (provided by Planning office clerk to be carried to Tax Commissioner's Office when applying for mobile home decal.)
- Ad Valorem Tax Receipt** to be provided by Tax Commissioner's Office (to replace a mobile home a tax receipt showing paid taxes on old mobile home is required at time of permit.)
- Septic Tank Permit** – Required if on septic. Obtain at Forsyth County Environmental Health Department (770-781-6909) prior to applying for building permit.

Fees – Building Permit Fee: \$93.75 Impact Fees can be found on the Forsyth County Finance Department website. Go to Forsythco.com..

- **Payment method:** Payment can be made with cash, check, credit or debit cards of Visa or MasterCard. Checks are made to Forsyth County.

GENERAL INFORMATION

For information concerning mobile home placement requirements in Forsyth County see the Unified Development Code of Forsyth County ([UDC 16-4.19](#))

Mobile home permits are issued for replacing older mobile homes and installation of new mobile homes. Mobile homes are only allowed in specific zonings. Mobile homes have a specific inspection process, including Site Location Inspection to check setbacks from property lines, a Final Plumbing Inspection to check water connection, a Final Electric Inspection to check power connection, and a Final Building Inspection to check tie downs, porches, decks and underpinning. Power cannot be connected until Final Building Inspection is completed and Certificate of Occupancy has been issued.

No manufactured or mobile home shall be installed or set up on site without first obtaining a permit from the Georgia Office of Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner and the department.

Per State Law all Manufactured Mobile Home permits must be obtained by Licensed Mobile Home Installer.

All site plans and permit cards are to remain onsite until a Certificate of Occupancy has been obtained


