## **Project Description**

The proposed project would consist of the widening of McGinnis Ferry Road from Sargent Road to Union Hill Road/Ronald Reagan Blvd located on the Fulton County line in southern Forsyth County. This project has been identified as part of Forsyth County's SPLOST program. The length of the proposed project is approximately 4.58 miles. The proposed design includes two lanes in each direction with a 20-foot raised median. The design speed is 45 mph. The proposed outside shoulder would be a 16-foot urban shoulder on the north side containing curb and gutter with a 10 foot multi-use path and on the south side would be a 12-foot urban shoulder containing curb and gutter with 6-foot sidewalks. Stage construction and traffic control devices will be utilized to maintain traffic during construction. Temporary lane closures may be required during stage construction.
