A structural report performed by a duly licensed engineer evidencing that any pole, decorative pole, or support structure will structurally support the collocation of any proposed wireless facility for collocation, or that the pole, decorative pole, or support structure may and will be modified to meet structural requirements, in accordance with applicable codes.
- 5. Visual depictions and representations for any new aboveground facilities to the extent such are not included in the required construction drawings.
- 6. Information indicating the horizontal and approximate vertical location, relative to the boundaries of the right of way, of the small wireless facility, to the extent such is not included in the required construction drawings.



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- 7. If the application is for the installation of new pole or replacement of a decorative pole, a certification that complies with the requirements of O.C.G.A. § 36-66C-6(k).
- 8. If the small wireless facility will be collocated on a pole or support structure owned by a third party (other than a County-owned pole), a certification that the applicant has permission from the owner to collocate on the pole or support structure.
- 9. If the applicant is not a wireless provider as defined in O.C.G.A. § 36-66C-2 and the County's Small Wireless Facilities and Antennas Ordinance, a certification that a wireless services provider has requested in writing that the applicant collocate the small wireless facilities or install, modify, or replace the pole or decorative pole at the requested location.
- 10. A signed and notarized certification that applicant has met with appropriate County Engineering Department staff at least thirty (30) days prior to submitting an application for a permit, and has informed the County, in good faith, when the applicant expects to commence deployment of small wireless facilities and poles within the County, the number of small wireless facilities and poles it expects to deploy during the twenty-four (24) months after commencement, and the expected timing of such deployments.
- 11. All fees must be paid upon submission of any application, including the following, as applicable:
  - a. \$100 per collocation of each small wireless facility
  - b. \$250 per replacement pole with an associated small wireless facility
  - c. \$1,000 per new pole with an associated small wireless facility
- 12. The required rate for the first year must be paid upon submission of any application, including the following, as applicable:
  - a. \$100 per year for each small wireless facility collocated on an existing or replacement pole
  - b. \$200 per year for each new pole with an associated small wireless facility



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The facility covered hereby shall be installed in accordance with the attached plans/drawings. Applicant agrees to abide with and be bound by the Department of Engineering Utility Accommodation Manual and current utility ordinance, as well as the County Small Wireless Facilities Ordinance and O.C.G.A. § 36-66C-1 et seq.
