Small Cell Permit Process

- 1. Meet with Engineering Department 30 days prior to application submission
- 2. Application submitted via US Mail or in person at the Engineering counter
- 3. Applications submitted by wireless providers shall include:
 - A. Applicant contact information.
 - B. Consultant contact information, if any consultants are acting on behalf of the applicant.
 - C. A general description of the proposed work, and the purpose and intent of the proposed facility.
 - D. Detailed construction drawings.
 - E. For collocations: A structural report by a duly licensed engineer evidencing that the pole or support structure will support the collocation.
 - F. Visual depictions if not included in the construction drawings.
 - G. Information indicating the horizontal and approximate vertical location, relative to the right of way.
 - H. If for collocation on a third-party pole, a certification that the applicant has permission from the third-party.
 - I. If the applicant is not a wireless service provider, a certification that a wireless service provider has requested the installation.
 - J. Material changes to information included in an application must be submitted in writing within 30 days after events necessitating the change.
 - K. All applicable fees.
- 4. Within 20 days of receiving an application, the County must:
 - A. Make a site visit
 - B. Notify the applicant of any anticipated applicable ROW changes.
 - C. Notify the applicant of any likely grounds for denial of the application.
 - D. Inform the applicant in writing if the application is incomplete and identify all missing information.
 - The applicant has 20 days to submit any missing information
 - If the application is still incomplete, or if changes have been made in the resubmission, the County shall notify the applicant within 10 days.
 - Absent agreement to the contrary, such notice constitutes a denial of the application.

Small Cell Permit Process

- 5. The County must make final decisions to approve or deny applications within the following timeframes:
 - A. Collocation Applications: 30 days of determining an application is complete.
 - B. Pole Applications: 70 days of determining the application is complete

Fees Paid:

- \$100 per collocation of each small wireless facility
- \$250 per replacement pole with an associated small wireless facility
- \$1,000 per new pole with an associated small wireless facility
