Public Transportation Access Forsyth

Access Forsyth (formerly Dial-A-Ride) (770) 781-2195

This is the county public transportation system provided to residents 18 and older on an appointment basis; there are no set routes. Appointments are made by phone and accepted up to 30 days in advance, on a first come, first served basis. All buses are equipped with lifts for wheelchair service. Riders must be ready at the door when the bus comes and be able to get themselves on and off the bus independently, with the exception of those in wheelchairs. Rides are restricted to within the county limits.

Residents call and leave a message, with the call being returned within 24 hours. This is the information needed: your name, date of ride, the location of pick-up, the location of drop-off, the time you need to be where you are going and/or the time you need to be picked up, and a return telephone number.

Fares

Trips are \$2 each way with exact change being required.

Hours

Passenger service is provided between the hours of 8:30 a.m. - 3 p.m. Monday through Friday. Rides must be booked through the dispatcher between the hours of 8 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday by calling (770) 781-2195.

Additional Public Transportation - Ride ShareProvided by nonprofit Common Courtesy using Uber or Lyft drivers.

Riders register in advance, either through the county Senior Services office at (770)781-2178 or on the county website, Public Transportation Department. A smart phone and credit card are required to participate in the program. Rides are also \$2 each way and are restricted to within the county.

Rides provided Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 5 p.m. Rides must be scheduled so that the passenger arrives at their final destination by 5 p.m.

SALT - Seniors and Lawmen Together

A monthly program offering interesting presentations on current topics affecting older adults. Meet deputies from the Sheriff's Office and have some good food and fun. The event is free and is held on the third Wednesday of the month.

CLEA - Citizens Law Enforcement Academy

Free nine-week course that meets from 6:30 - 9:30 p.m. on consecutive Mondays. The Academy is open to all Forsyth County residents, employees and business owners age 21 and over. CLEA provides students with hands-on training and law enforcement knowledge in a friendly environment. The goal is to build a closer bond with the citizens and business owners of Forsyth County through communication and education.

Senior Safety Classes

The Sheriff's Office will bring the following classes to any group of 10 or more seniors (neighborhoods, church groups, civic organizations, etc.) free of charge.

Senior Safety Awareness

Designed to educate our Forsyth County senior citizens about different scams that are targeting seniors and teach them internet safety and situational awareness.

WSD - Women's Self Defense

This course is designed to teach women situational awareness by reviewing case studies of previous abductions. Some hands-on training is provided but limited. This class is designed for women and reserved for women only.

CRASE - Citizens Response to Active Shooter Event
 This class is designed to teach you what to do/not do in
 the case of an active shooter in your place of business,
 church, school, local store or anywhere this type of
 horrific act could occur.

Mailbox Books

Forsyth County Public Library can mail materials directly to your home if you are unable to visit the library. The Mailbox Books program offers the convenience of receiving and returning materials in a postage-paid mail pouch.

This service is open to Forsyth County Public Library patrons who:

- Have a permanent or temporary disability or medical condition that prevents a person from visiting the library.
- Reside in a nursing care or assisted living facility, whether temporarily or permanently.
- Have other health conditions that make a person unable to visit the library.
