Candidates for the U.S. Congressional, State Senate, State Representative, County Commission (Districts 2, 4 & 5 are the only Commissioners up for election in 2016) and County Board of Education (Districts 3, 4 & 5 are the only Board Members up for election in 2016) are elected by district.
