This is a Consolidated Sample Ballot which contains ALL Republican candidates, Republican Party Questions, and NonPartisan Judges. Candidates for the U.S. Congressional, State Senate, State Representative, County Commission (Districts 2, 4 & 5 are the only Commissioners up for election in 2016) and County Board of Education (Districts 3, 4 & 5 are the only Board Members up for election in 2016) are elected by district. To determine which races will be on your ballot check your voter registration precinct card for your district information or contact our office.

Vote on Election Day, Tuesday, May 24 from 7am to 7pm at your designated polling place or at any of the Advance Voting Locations during the hours listed- see below.
