

QUALIFIED WRITE-IN CANDIDATES

November 8, 2016

In a General Election candidates may qualify as a Write-In Candidate. In order to become a write-in candidate an individual must have posted their intention in the county's legal organ by a specific deadline and completed a set of paperwork by the deadline. Write-In candidate names do not appear on the General Election ballot and (and did not appear on the General Primary ballot as they did not qualify with a Party), but any votes cast for these candidates using the write-in option will be counted.
