Early Tabulation of Absentee Ballots
For the May 22, 2018, General Primary and Nonpartisan General Election
and Special Elections

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections hereby provides public notice of the County Election Superintendent's intent to begin the absentee ballot tabulation process prior to the close of the polls on May 22, 2018. Pursuant to Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 21-2-386(a)(3), the Forsyth County Election Superintendent shall open absentee ballots and begin tabulating absentee ballots beginning at 6:00 p.m. on May 22, 2018 at the Voter Registrations and Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, GA 30040 in order to expedite the final tabulation of absentee ballots. The tabulation process will be monitored as authorized by law. In addition, all persons conducting the tabulation of absentee ballots on May 22, 2018, including the Vote Review Panel required by law, shall be sequestered until the time for the closing of the polls.
