Absentee Vote By Mail: Accepting Applications/Mailing Ballots Now Through Friday, March 20

Early/Saturday/Advance Voting In Person: Weekdays, March 2-20 and Saturday, March 14.  
Locations and Hours vary by day.

Vote at Election Day at your designated Polling Place: Tuesday, March 24

### WHAT IS A PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY?

The upcoming election consists of the statewide **Presidential Preference Primary**, which has been called so that voters may express their preference for one person to be the candidate for nomination by such person's party or body for the office of President of the United States. **NOTE:** There will be **NO** Runoff for the Presidential Preference Primary.

### GEORGIA VOTERS DO NOT REGISTER BY PARTY.

In Georgia, voters do not register by party. For the PPP, each voter must choose either a Democratic or Republican ballot type when requesting a ballot.

## **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: February 24, 2020**

In Georgia to be eligible to vote in any election and any subsequent runoff, voters must be registered to vote 30 days prior to that election.

**The Voter Registration Deadline for this election is: Monday, February 24, 2020**

Forsyth County residents desiring to register to vote or change their name and/or address may do so:

**Online:** To use the Online Voter Registration System, you must have a valid driver's license or identification card issued by the GA Department of Driver Services (DDS) with your signature on file with DDS. The Application must be dated no later than 11:59 p.m. on the Voter Registration Deadline date. If you do not have a valid driver's license or identification card, you will be allowed to print and manually submit a paper registration. The Application must be USPS postmarked by the Voter Registration Deadline date or delivered in person to our office no later than the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the Voter Registration Deadline date in order to be eligible to vote in the upcoming election. **In person:** You may register to vote at the Forsyth County Voter Registrations and Elections Office, located at 1201 Sawnee Dr., Cumming, GA 30040 or at any public library in the county. The Elections Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Applications can be downloaded at [www.forsythco.com](http://www.forsythco.com) and are also available at the Elections Office and at any public library.

**By Mail:** A Voter Registration Application must be completely filled out and signed. The Application must be USPS postmarked by the Voter Registration Deadline or delivered in person to our office no later than the close of business (4:30 p.m.) on the Voter Registration Deadline in order to be eligible to vote in the upcoming election.

All properly completed applications received by the Voter Registrations and Elections Office not meeting the above deadline will be processed after the March 24, 2020 Presidential Preference Primary. These applicants will be eligible to vote in future elections.

## **VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

In order to be eligible to register to vote a person must be: a citizen of the United States and the State of Georgia, at least 17 ½ years of age, a resident of the county or municipality in which he/she seeks to vote, cannot be currently serving a felony conviction, AND cannot have been judicially determined to be mentally incompetent to vote.

## **PHOTO ID REQUIRED TO VOTE**

Remember, all voters voting in person will be asked to provide one of the six acceptable forms of photo identification. Proper photo ID shall consist of any one of the following: GA driver's license (valid or expired), Valid ID card by any state or U.S. with photo, Valid U.S. passport, Valid government employee photo ID, Valid U.S. military ID card with photo, OR Valid tribal ID card with photo.

If you do not have one of these forms of photo identification, you are eligible to receive a free Georgia ID card for Voting Purposes ONLY. These cards are issued in the Voter Registrations and Elections Office. Please call us at 770-781-2118 for more information or to schedule an appointment to have a free Georgia ID card for Voting Purposes made.

Advance Voting runs from March 2 through March 20 at select polling places Any Forsyth County registered voter may take advantage of Advance Voting in person during the hours and dates listed below, regardless of where they are assigned to vote on Election Day. ### **ABSENTEE VOTING TURNOUT STATISTICS**

The Forsyth County Voter Registrations and Elections Office posts the Absentee Voting Turnout Statistics, which includes Absentee Voting by Mail as well as Absentee Voting In Person (Advance Voting), to our website daily. The turnout statistics posted are through the day before and are posted by approximately 11:00 a.m. *All totals are unofficial and incomplete until certified by the Board of Voter Registrations and Elections.*

## **Vote at Your Convenience: How to Have a Paper Ballot Mailed to You**

It's easy. All persons desiring to have a ballot mailed to them must first submit a written request to the Forsyth County Voter Registrations and Elections Office by mail, email of a scanned copy, fax *or* personal delivery. The request must contain the voter's name and address as registered, mailing address (if different from registration address), date of birth, the date of the election (**March 24, 2020**) **AND** must be signed by the voter.

The simplest way to apply for an Absentee Ballot by mail is to complete an Application for Official Absentee Ballot. This application can be found online at <https://www.forsythco.com/Departments-Offices/Voter-Registrations-Elections>. Voters may also contact our office to have an absentee ballot application mailed or faxed to them.

## **DEADLINE TO REQUEST A PAPER BALLOT BE MAILED TO YOU**

Voters may request an absentee ballot by mail beginning 180 days prior to an election. You may request an absentee ballot for the March 24, 2020 PPP now. **Requests for absentee ballots are usually processed within 3 business days after receipt in our office. The last day an absentee ballot can be mailed for the March 24 PPP is Friday, March 20, 2020. The absentee ballot application must be received in our office by the close of business (4:30 p.m.) in order to be processed and mailed by Friday, March 20.**

**WHAT IS AN ABSENTEE VOTER?** Per Georgia Election Code 21-2-380 (a) the term “absentee elector” means an elector of this state who casts a ballot in a primary, election or runoff other than in person at the polls on Election Day. All this means is that any voter who votes in person during Advance Voting or who requests their ballot be mailed to them are classified as ‘Absentee Voters.’ They are ‘absent’ from their polling place on Election Day and there is no reason required to request a ballot be mailed to the voter.

## **WHEN AND HOW THE VOTED-BY-MAIL ABSENTEE BALLOT MUST BE RETURNED**

Absentee ballots can be returned to our office either by mail or by personal delivery. The last day our office can receive a voted Absentee Ballot is on Election Day. The ballot must be turned by 7:00 p.m. to the Elections Office in order to be counted. (There are special provisions for voters in the military and/or living overseas. Contact our office for details).

## **WHEN WILL MY VOTED ABSENTEE BALLOT BE OPENED?**

On Election Day. All absentee ballots remain sealed and under lock and key until that day. And, yes, following GA Election Code all absentee ballots submitted and accepted are counted in the final totals for every election.

## **ABSENTEE VOTING TURNOUT STATISTICS**

The Forsyth County Voter Registrations and Elections Office posts the Absentee Voting Turnout Statistics, which includes Absentee Voting by Mail as well as Absentee Voting In Person (Advance Voting), to our website daily. The turnout statistics posted are through the day before and are posted by approximately 11:00 a.m.

## VOTING ON ELECTION DAY, Voting Hours 7am to 7pm

On Election Day, Tuesday, March 24, 2020 voters must go to their designated polling place to vote. All twenty Election Day polling places are open for voting from 7am to 7pm on Election Day.

### Things to Note on Election Day:

**\*NEW POLLING PLACES, effective January 2020:** Attention voters: 5 new Election Day polling places opened in 2020. The designated Election Day polling place has changed for approximately 50,000 registered voters in Forsyth County. Please verify your Election Day polling place at [www.mvp.sos.ga.gov](http://www.mvp.sos.ga.gov) prior to going to the polls.

**\*Advance Voting Location MAY NOT be Your Designated Election Day Polling Place**

Remember, four of the five Advance Voting locations (Hampton Park Library, Midway Park Community Building, Sharon Springs Park Community Building and Parks & Recreation Natural Resources Operations Center) are also Election Day polling places. However, ON Election Day ONLY those voters who are assigned to those designated polling places should go there to vote.

**\*The Forsyth County Elections Office IS NOT Open for Voting ON Election Day**

The Forsyth County Elections Office is open for all of Advance Voting BUT IS NOT an Election Day polling place. Our office is open all day on Election Day to answer any questions a voter may have; however, there is NO voting in the building ON Election Day. A voter's polling place ON Election Day is specific to where their residence (as registered) falls within designated precinct lines.

**ELECTION DAY VOTING TURNOUT STATISTICS**

On Election Day, the Election Day Voting Turnout Statistics by precinct will be posted to our website at approximately 7:30 a.m., 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.

**IN PERSON OBSERVATION OF TABULATION**

Advance Voting, Absentee By Mail and Election Day totals are not tabulated until after the polls close on Election Night. On Election Night (after the polls have closed), the public may observe the tabulation of votes at the Forsyth County Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, 30040. Election results will be displayed and announced until all votes are tallied with the exception of provisional votes, which are tabulated at the time the Board meets to certify the election.



The Board of Voter Registrations and Elections meets to certify the election results following Election Day. At this time, the Board also reviews all provisional ballots cast. The date and time for certification will be posted to the Forsyth County Voter Registrations and Elections webpage. *All election result totals are unofficial and incomplete until certified by the Board of Voter Registrations and Elections.*
